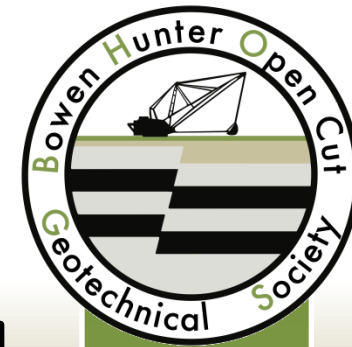

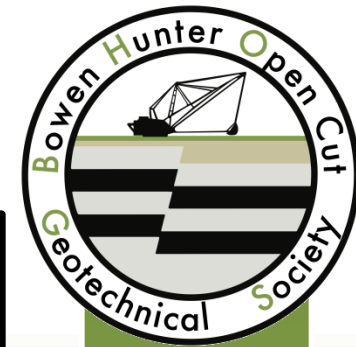

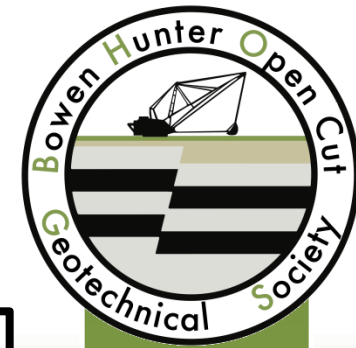
BOHOGS - Year in Review

- 24 & 25 Oct - Galena and I-Site training – Brisbane. Galena training postponed to a date to be determined. Good feedback on the I-Site training session.

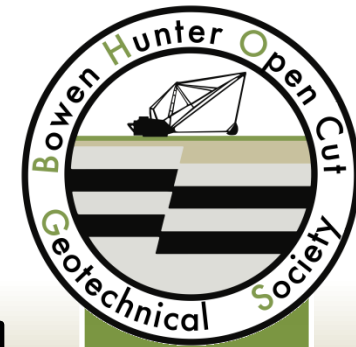

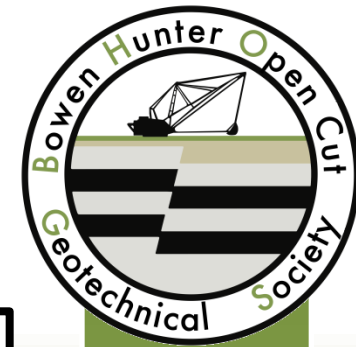

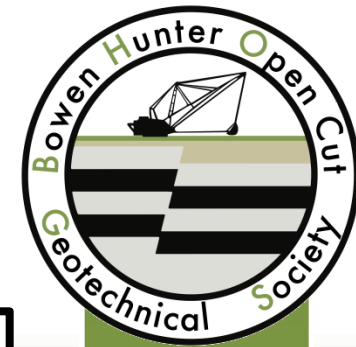
“Customer” satisfaction survey and Constitution amendments



- The first notification was not received by all members due to an issue with MailChimp and the firewalls of certain companies. A second invitation to these two “SurveyMonkey” surveys was sent out at the end of July
- The amended constitution was read by 20 respondents who all accepted the changes. The amended constitution has now been accepted by the members and will be posted on our website for reference. The main change is that due to our geographic “spread” it is very difficult to arrange an AGM where we can get a good cross section of our members. The AGM will now be held electronically (an eAGM) and this needs to happen before the end of the calendar year.

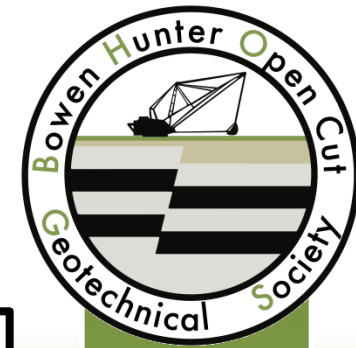


Some Points of Interest

- We had a total of 18 responses – all ordinary members – no responses from sponsors. Not sure what to read into that.
- The average number of events attended in 2016 was slightly lower than 2015 (1.5 vs 1.7)
- Site visits & meetings were the top activities in order of preference, networking type events were less appreciated
- Unsurprisingly, the opportunity to learn from others and exposure to new ideas was the key benefit of meetings
- Of the items ranked as less important, software training got more than one mention, inability to motivate site managers to allow attendance at other events was also mentioned more than once
- Some excellent suggested improvements: mini-symposia, half-day lectures to go into a particular subject in detail rather than short presentations, workshops (e.g. our legal requirements). Maybe the 2018 Committee can introduce one or two of these.
- As a professional development platform BOHOGS was rated good by 76% and adequate by 24% of respondents. It would be good to see the “good” percentage climb in future years.

Awarded Geotechnical Practitioner of the Year – **GAVIN LOWING**

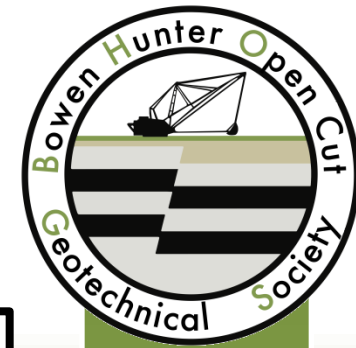


For Gavin's significant contribution to the field of Open Cut Geotechnical Engineering through the following endeavours:

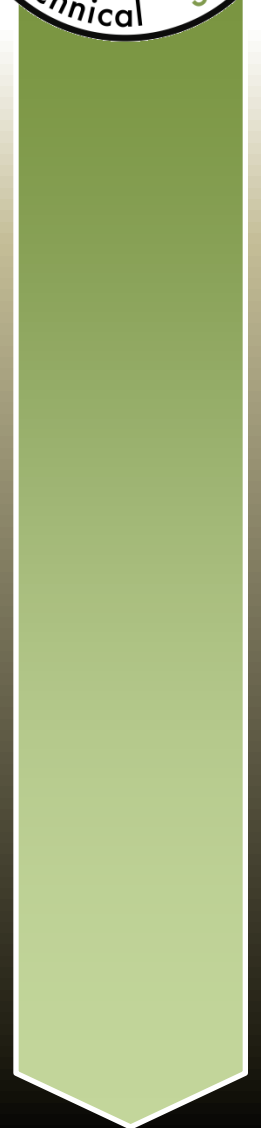

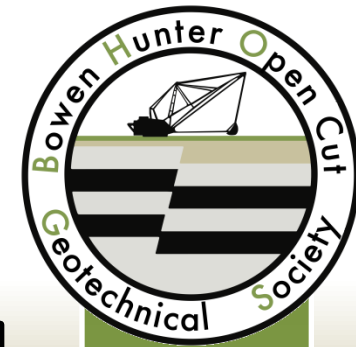
