UNSW Minerals Scholarship Program

New Scholarships worth \$1.14m over 4 years

The School of Mining Engineering is pleased to announce 25 new scholarships available to students commencing 1st and 2nd year studies in Mining Engineering (or Mining Engineering dual degrees) in 2017.

Background

Given the cyclical nature of the minerals industry, support is needed to ensure a steady intake of undergraduate students into the Mining Engineering program, and subsequently provide enough graduate mining engineers to industry.

The NSW minerals industry has been a significant supporter of Mining Education at UNSW and wishes to increase this support to further encourage students into the industry.

The NSW Minerals Industry/UNSW Education Trust is offering students of exceptional academic ability the opportunity to undertake the Bachelor of Mining Engineering at UNSW.

Value

- \$12,000 per year for 4 years
- Scholarship holders will also receive assistance in securing Industrial Training placements

Eligibility

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be an Australian Citizen or Australian permanent resident; and
- Be eligible for entry into the undergraduate engineering program at UNSW in 2017
- Be commencing full-time in their first year or second of study in mining engineering (single or dual programs) at UNSW.

Note: The Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Flexible First Year) is also eligible for this Scholarship.
